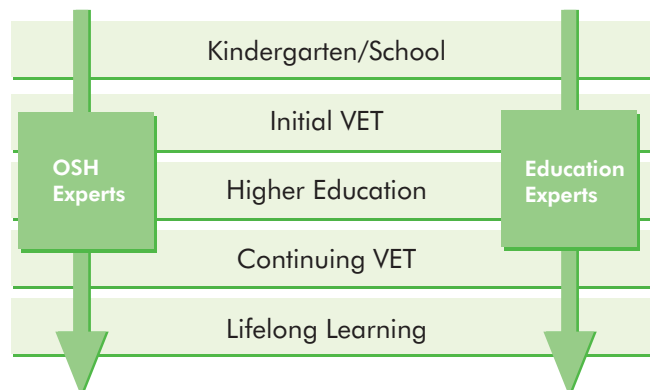
ABOUT THE PROJECT

The foremost objective of the project is to establish a "European network education and training in occupational safety and health" which will be the first to compile European experience in the mainstreaming of occupational safety and health into education and training and will promote the use of good practice across national and cultural boundaries.

Within the network, education experts will work hand-in-hand with OSH professionals at national and international level.

The project follows an integral approach in which safety and health education does not begin with entry into working life, but is conducted at all levels, from kindergarten, through primary and secondary school, vocational training and academic study, to preparation for retirement.
