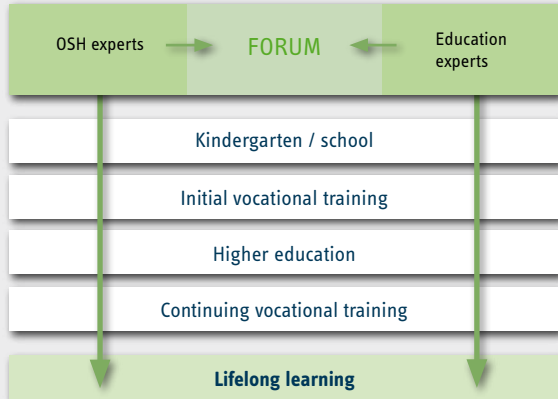
The European Network Education and Training in Occupational Safety and Health (ENETOSH) offers the first and currently the only platform for systematic knowledge-sharing on issues concerning education and training in occupational safety and health.

The network was set up with the financial support of the European Commission as part of the LEONARDO DA VINCI programme from October 2005 until September 2007. The project started out with 13 partners from 10 countries.

Today, more than 40 partners from 16 European countries plus South Korea and the USA are involved in ENETOSH. The network is coordinated by the Institute for Work and Health of the German Social Accident Insurance (DGUV).

The idea that safety and health are an integral part of lifelong learning guides the work of ENETOSH, which is why it covers all areas of education, from kindergarten to school, initial vocational training, higher education through to continuing vocational training.

ENETOSH Standard of competence

The ENETOSH Standard of Competence is intended to assure the quality of instructors and trainers of occupational safety and health in Europe. The standard covers the following fields of competence: Training the trainer - Safety and health at work - Workplace Health Promotion - OSH management. The ENETOSH Standard of Competence has been recognised by 14 institutions from 10 European

countries and is available in 11 languages. It is a recommendation and can be used by educational institutions for recruitment purposes or CPD for teaching staff.
