**Short description of the institution/project**

The BGW is the statutory accident insurance institution responsible for non-governmental institutions for health service and welfare work. The statutory accident insurance, as a part of the German social insurance system, is a public body. Legally assigned tasks are carried out in autonomous responsibility under governmental supervision. With more than five million insurants in approximately 500.000 enterprises, the BGW represents the second largest institution for statutory accident insurance and prevention. Its headquarter is located in Hamburg. Its priority tasks involve prevention and therefore avoidance of occupational accidents, illnesses and health risks. In the event of damage the BGW guarantees an optimal medical, occupational and social rehabilitation as well as an appropriate compensation. Furthermore, the BGW supports entrepreneurs in the implementation of their legally assigned tasks and realises these projects under the supervision of the state.

The presentation demonstrates, with which materials the BGW is going to provide and support teachers of vocational schools. The educational material has been developed for instructors of medical assistants, dental assistants, hairdressers, elderly care nurses and veterinary assistants. There, propositions for the application of different methods, medias and topics are provided, which are helpful for teaching occupational and health prevention.
